Rules and Regulations

1. **ALL** teams **MUST** be registered with an affiliated club, players must be registered with their District Association as an indoor player for 2007-2008, and will be required to show their OSA Player Registration Books on tournament day.
2. Each team must obtain **Permission to Travel** from its District Association prior to entry deadline and submit it with their registration form in order to be considered registered. Failure to present a Travel Permit will result in forfeiture of all scheduled games without refund.
3. All games in the following age divisions will consist of:
Under 10 - Under 12 teams will play with 8 players including goalkeeper.
Under 14 teams will play with 7 players including goalkeeper.
4. All games are 2*20 minutes in duration. There is no half-time (2 minutes allowed to change sides).
5. The three line violation will not be called by the referee. If a player passes the ball across three lines in the air towards the opponent's goal without touching another player or the referee, the referee will not stop the play.
6. The ball will be kicked in, not thrown in.
7. If the ball makes contact with the ceiling or an object on the ceiling during play, play will be stopped and an indirect free kick will be awarded to the team that did not have possession of the ball when it was kicked.
8. Substitution of players with the exception of the goalkeeper may be made at any time during the game provided the substitute does not enter the field of play until the player being replaced is within 1 metre of the bench area. Substitute must enter the field between the two marked lines by their own bench. The substitution of the goalkeeper must be done during a stoppage in play.
9. If any team pulls its goalkeeper, the player coming on must wear a jersey of a different colour from the rest of his/her team to distinguish himself/herself.
10. Teams may carry a maximum of 18 players.
11. Team roster, including full name of player, provincial registrant number and date of birth **MUST** be submitted prior to the first game. It **cannot** change during the tournament.
12. Team sheets **MUST** be submitted to referee prior to each game
13. Trial Permits and Temporary Registration permits for guest players are allowed with proper validation by District Association. (Maximum of 3 players per team.)
14. Teams may use players that are registered in their club from an equal or younger age group. These players must be registered and have their OSA Player Registration Books present.
15. All free kicks are indirect (except the penalty kick).
16. If a player receives a red card or dismissal in a game he/she will be disciplined in accordance with the O.S.A. Policies and Procedures.
17. If the final is tied at the end of regulation time the game will go directly to Kicks from the Penalty Mark. (5 Kicks will be taken. More kicks may be necessary if there is a tie). Result at the end of the game will stand in other placement games.
18. A) Tie Breaker in Group Play
 - 1) Head to Head
 - 2) Goal Difference
 - 3) Most Goals
 - 4) Goal Average
 - 5) Kicks from Penalty Mark (5 kicks, more if needed in case of tie)
19. Wild Card Play off spots will be decided by Tie Breaking procedures in group play Rule 16

when teams play the same number of games in round robin. If groups are uneven and teams play a different number of games, then the Wild Card will be determined by the best goal average of the teams in second place in each group.

20.If a team has been disqualified all games will be null and void.

21.Failure to appear for a game will result in a 1-0 loss. Remaining games will be played as scheduled.

22.Any team wishing to protest a game must do so in writing no later than 15 minutes after the game. This letter must be accompanied with \$100.00 cash. If the protest is upheld the \$100.00 will be returned.

23.For any issues not covered in the above, a decision will be made by the Tournament convenor. All decisions will be final.

24.All other rules as per the OSA Indoor Soccer Rules.

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
